



Brazil survey: forgiving cheating in a relationship

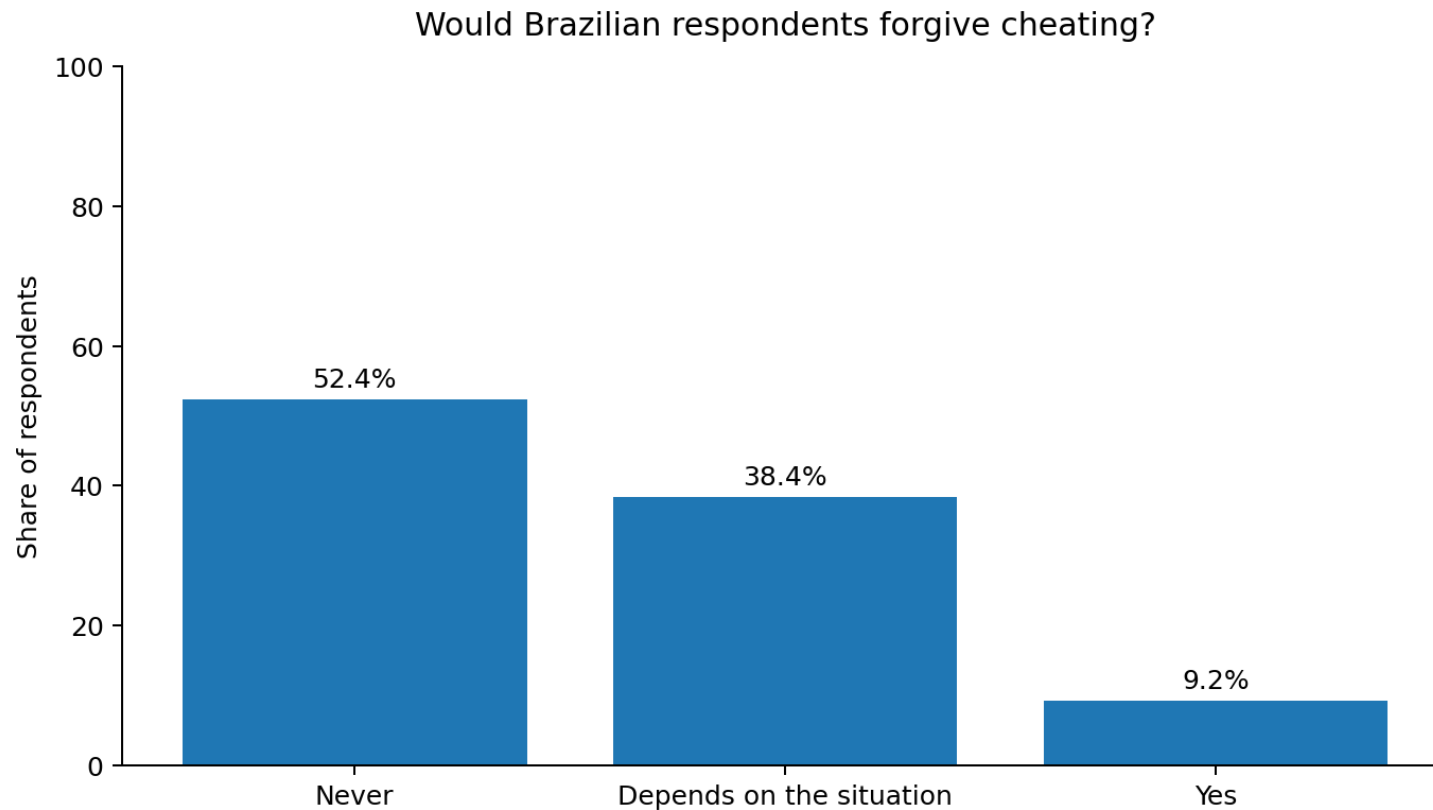
More than half of Brazilian respondents said they would never forgive cheating.

52.4%	38.4%	9.2%

The survey was conducted through Bohemian Research respondent apps MultiPolls, Golden Surveys and RewardRoo. The analysis included 502 complete responses from Brazil.

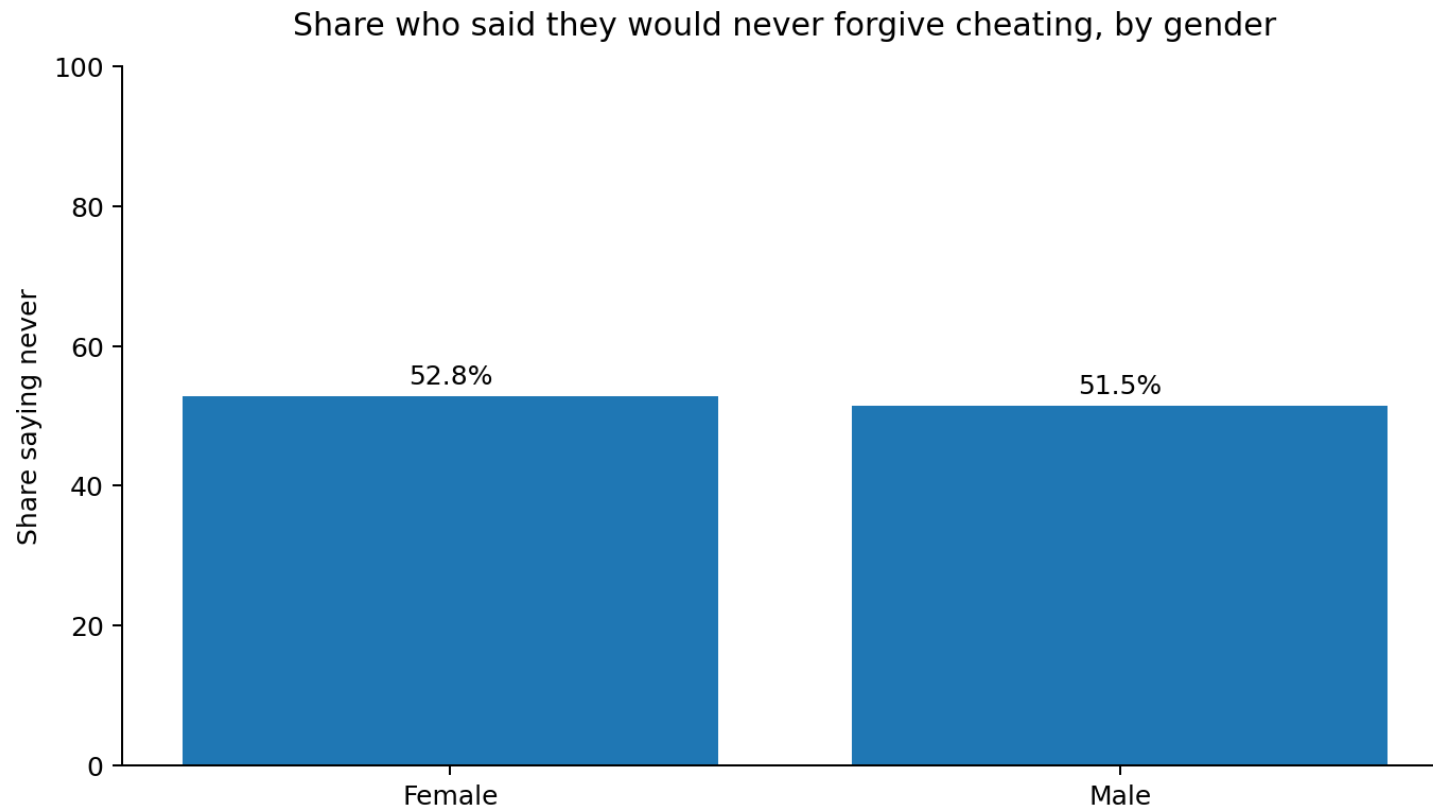
Overall result

The most common answer was "never". Nearly four in ten respondents said the answer would depend on the situation.



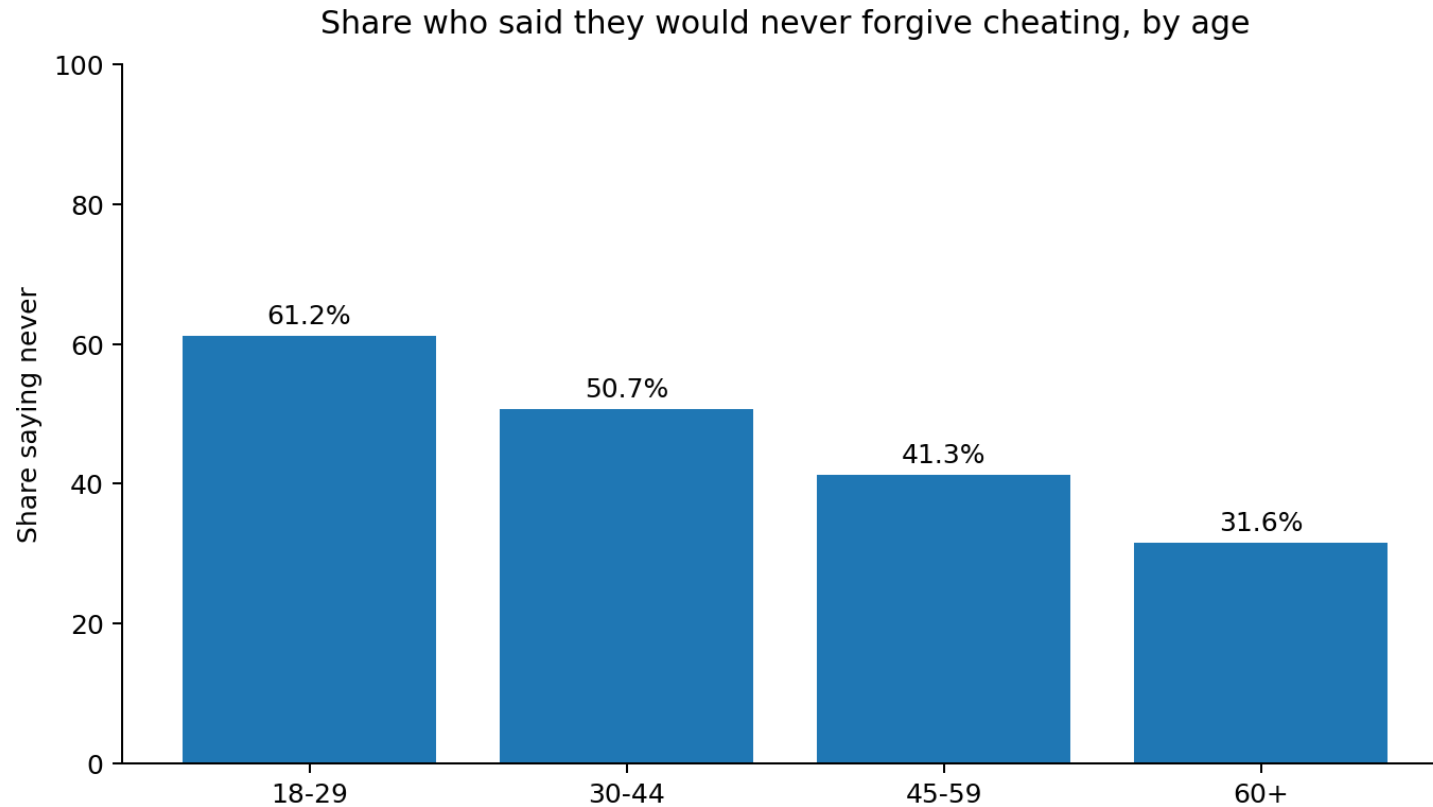
Gender differences

Women and men answered similarly on whether they would never forgive cheating. The bigger difference was in the share saying yes: 13.2% of men selected yes, compared with 7.2% of women.



Age differences

Younger respondents were more likely to say they would never forgive cheating. The share was 61.2% among respondents aged 18 to 29. The 60+ subgroup was small, so it should be interpreted with caution.



Key findings

- 52.4% of Brazilian respondents said they would never forgive cheating.
- 38.4% said it would depend on the situation.
- Only 9.2% said they would forgive cheating.
- The share saying never was similar among women (52.8%) and men (51.5%).
- Respondents aged 18 to 29 were the most likely age group to say never (61.2%).

Methodology

The survey was conducted on May 25, 2026 through Bohemian Research respondent apps MultiPolls, Golden Surveys and RewardRoo. The analysis included 502 complete responses from respondents in Brazil. Respondents answered the question: "Would you forgive cheating?" Results are presented for respondents included in the survey and were not weighted.
